ARTICLE IV: ELIGIBILITY

SECTION 1: Members

All journeyman and apprentices in "Good Standing" who have contributed to the Fund may receive tuition reimbursements for part-time, job related courses or college credits upon successfully completing courses of study at an accredited college, trade school or technical institute.

SECTION 2: Dependants

All dependants of journeyman members in "Good Standing" who have made contributions to the Fund who meet all of the requirements detailed below shall be eligible for benefits from the Fund:

- (a) must be a dependant of an eligible Local Union 131 journeyman member, per Internal Revenue definitions, at the time of initial application
- (b) must be under the age of twenty-five (25) at the time of initial application
- (c) must have a high school diploma (or its equivalent)
- (d) must be accepted at an accredited college, trade school or technical institute and enrolled in a degree or certificate producing program

ARTICLE V: APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

An application must be submitted each year for expenses incurred in the 12 months immediately prior to the application date. All applications for Scholarship Reimbursement Funds must be signed and submitted to the Scholarship Fund Committee by the advertised deadline. Each application must meet the following criteria:

- (a) contain proof of passing grade(s) at a qualifying institution
- (b) contain copy of receipts showing total of payments made to said institution
- (c) all <u>other</u> scholarship payments received from other sources must be deducted from the total expenses claimed/requested for reimbursement
